Annual Flower and Plant Sale

With the order blank for the annual plant sale being in this newsletter, spring must be coming. Of course, for most of us, it is not soon enough. We offer annual bedding plants, perennials, hanging baskets, flowering pots (mixed or one type of plant), vegetables, herbs and a new offering this year, plant gift certificates (see the next paragraph). Unfortunately, some of the prices have changed as the cost of the plants to us has increased. There are some new plants available and most of the regulars are still on the list. If you want plants that are not on the list, please indicate that on the order blank, and we will have them for you if they are available from Furst who has always supplied our plants for our sales. They are always of the highest quality and are beautiful. We receive compliments every year on the gorgeous plants that we have in our sale. Last year, we sold about twenty-six thousand dollars of plants. We would love to sell even more this year. Please remember to tell your friends, co-workers, family, etc. about our sale. Our prices are very competitive, and the quality is so much better than the plants available in most stores. Please send your order, with payment, by March 6th. If you need extra copies of the order blank to pass to other people, we can send them to you or the order blank is also available on our website, thetenthlife.org. The plants will be available for pick-up on May 4th after 4:30pm. They can also be

picked up each evening from 4:30–7:30pm during the week, 10:30am–5:00pm on Saturday and 12:30-5:00pm on Sunday. Please pick-up your order as soon as possible as space is very limited. Last year we had over two hundred and sixty orders. In addition, we always purchase about three thousand dollars of extra plants for your shopping convenience. Of course, pre-ordering is always the best option to guarantee getting all of your desired plants. We try to have a wide selection of each color and variety, but it is very difficult to be able to satisfy everyone’s desires with the extras. Therefore, please pre-order if possible. If you miss the order date, please send your order in, and we will accommodate your wishes as much as possible. We understand that March is very early to begin thinking of flowers, but we must order early to secure the best prices on the plants and to assure that Furst can meet our requirements for plants. Please send your orders in as soon as possible and make our ordering easier. However, we do need your orders to make the sale a success. Even if it is almost time for the plants to be delivered, give us your order, and we will fill your order from the extras or increase our order from Furst, if possible. We try very hard to accommodate our customers’ requests. Please remember that the plants arrive just in time for Mother’s Day and make wonderful gifts for everyone on your list. They will be thrilled with your thoughtfulness.

This year we are offering a new option for the flower sale. We have gift certificates for your gift-giving needs. You can purchase one of our gift certificates for plants and have the recipient come to The Tenth Life and choose his/her own plants. The certificate can be for any amount you desire. This is a wonderful idea for people who are very hard to shop for but love flowers. They will be thrilled, and you will be spared the task of choosing flowers for them. Simply note on your order blank that you want a gift certificate and state the dollar amount and the recipient’s name. We have a gorgeous gift certificate format already designed for this purpose.

Your generous donations provided twenty-one thousand four hundred dollars to the general fund this holiday season. These are the funds that we use for the day-to-day operation of The Tenth Life, such as food, litter, supplies, medicines, Dr. Jennie’s salary, utilities, etc. Your donations help with the operation of the organization and allow the cats to live a quality life with all of the amenities. Thank you.

We have three new volunteers that we welcome to The Tenth Life. Their help will enrich the lives of the cats and lessen the workload of the other volunteers. We are thrilled to have them volunteering with us.

Nine more of the cats now have sponsors. They are so happy and their smiles are never-ending. Of course, there are many more that do not have sponsors. If you

have been thinking about sponsoring, there is no better time than now. You can make another cat happy for only ten dollars per month. You will receive a letter from your sponsor cat and his or her picture and an update every six months until the cat is adopted. The donations of supplies this holiday season were fantastic as they were all year. We received all types of items including paper towels, bleach, wipes, cat food, dryer sheets, postage stamps, etc. We thank everyone who contributed for their help.

We also received donations to the x-ray fund. These donations totaled two thousand dollars. We are still a long way from being able to afford a new x-ray machine, but that is fine as long as the existing one continues to work. We will keep saving for this need until sufficient funds are available.

Status of the Website

We met our goal of having our website up and running by December 1st. It is still a bit of a work in progress as there are many things still being done to the site. You can access the site by going to “thetenthlife.org”, or “thetenthlife.com”. There is an abundance of information available on the site from The Tenth Life history to how to contact us to making donations through the web site. It is intended to be informative and entertaining at the same time. Please visit the site and see all the information which is available today. In the future we intend to have information about many (if not all) of the cats of The Tenth Life who are looking for their special homes. The data base will have pictures of the kitties along with their history to include: source, age, coloration, gender, spay/neuter date, vaccination history, etc. We are not sure when the data base will be ready, but hope to have it functional within the next couple of weeks. Then it will be a matter of taking all the pictures and populating the database with the proper information. We will let you know when this is all ready for public

consumption. In the meantime, check the site periodically for information updates and, hopefully, the data base of cats. You can use the calendar to check on upcoming events, access the latest newsletter, or get a copy of the flower order directly from the site. We do hope that you find it enjoyable and informative. Our undying thanks go out to Mike Boehringer for doing all the important stuff in getting the site up and running. He has really put in a monumental effort to make it happen when we said it would. He is still updating the site and ensuring that things continue to go well with it. Thanks Mike.

Past Fund Raisers

The Thanksgiving pie sale provided four hundred dollars of income with the sale of one hundred and fifteen pies. In addition, the Christmas pie sale on December 19th produced nearly three hundred dollars of profit with the sale of eighty-three pies. The pies were delicious and everyone loved them.

As always the greenery and plants were aromatic and beautiful. We thank Furst for the gorgeous plants, our wholesaler for the festive greenery, and Unique Designs Floral Studio for the attractive red bows that are such a nice complement to the wreaths. Our customers were extremely pleased with the greenery and plants. The sale made over fifteen hundred dollars for the cats. We thank the volunteers who helped with the wreath sale and our customers who purchased wreaths, roping, and plants. We plan to offer the greenery and plants next year.

The two Tenth Life bazaars (November 28th and December 19th) in association with the bake sale on December 19th were very profitable. The proceeds from the three events were nearly forty-two hundred dollars. Our bazaars made holiday shopping easy for our customers and produced huge profits for the cats. Our best sellers were the catnip toys and The Tenth Life apparel, Christmas cards and cookbooks. We appreciate the support from our visitors. We thank everyone who baked for the bake sale and all of our customers who purchased the baked goods. For the

bake sale we had about fifty-five varieties of cakes, cookies, and candies. Everything was so delicious and sold very well. Many of our supporters cannot wait for the bake sale because we have such a huge variety of delicious baked goods. Our next bake sale will be for Easter.

Our pictures with Santa program at Complete Petmarts was the most successful one that we have had. We had volunteers at four Complete Petmarts playing Santa and taking pictures of Santa with customer's pets. We participated at the Beavercreek, Oakwood, Springboro, and Cross Pointe Center Complete Petmarts. We thank the stores and their employees for allowing The Tenth Life to be involved in this entertaining program. Our volunteers love being a part of this program and working with the animals and their owners. The owners contributed nearly fifteen hundred dollars to The Tenth Life through these picture-taking sessions. We plan to participate again during the 2010 holiday season.

On December 9th we were the guest of the Books & Company at the Greene. They held a book fair for The Tenth Life with part of the sales coming to our cats. We should be receiving the check for the last two book fairs very soon. We will not know the earnings until we receive the check. We thank Books & Company for allowing us to have the book fairs at their store and earning money for the cats.

Current Fund Raisers

A couple of years ago we offered Pet Hair Magnets for removing pet hair from all types of fabric. Our supporters loved them, but we were unable to find a source for more of them when our supply was exhausted. We now have a new supply. The price is still ten dollars. They work really well for getting pet hair off your clothes, furniture, carpeting (especially steps), etc. They look very much like a small squeegee and really work wonders. You will be surprised at how much hair you remove from your furniture. The Pet Hair magnets will be available at The Tenth Life and at the Yellow Springs Street Fair in June and October and

the Beavercreek Popcorn Festival in September. If you would like, we can also mail one to you for an extra two dollars for postage. Everyone with pets is always looking for a way to remove pet hair from furniture, drapes, carpeting or clothing, and these really do work very well.

The sale of Entertainment books is progressing well. We still have Dayton books left for sale. The books allow you to enjoy a special event or dinner at a fraction of the cost. The books sell for thirty dollars and are loaded with coupons that will save you hundreds of dollars with the use of a few of them. If you attend LaComedia and use the coupon from the book you will pay for the book two times with just the one coupon. In addition, you have all the rest of the coupons in the book to use. What makes this year's book even better is that there are gift cards on the front of the book that total twenty dollars. There is one card for five dollars off any purchase (no minimum purchase required) from Cassano's, Steak and Shake, TGIFriday's, and Gordon Food Service. The current books do not expire until next November; therefore, there is plenty of time to recover your investment. The books are available from The Tenth Life, several of our volunteers, at the retail locations listed below or by mail for an additional three dollars for postage. The businesses selling books for The Tenth Life are as follows: Complete Petmarts at Cross Pointe Center, Lofino's Plaza in Beavercreek, and on Far Hills in Oakwood, Dayton South Veterinary Clinic on Wilmington Pike in Kettering, The Scratching Post Cat Hospital on Franklin Street in Centerville, Beavercreek Cleaners on Indian Ripple Road in Beavercreek, Fine Cleaners on Fairfield Road in Beavercreek, and The Corner Copy Shop on Dayton-Xenia Road in Beavercreek. Please visit these businesses to purchase an Entertainment book and possibly make a purchase from the business as a thank-you for helping The Tenth Life. You do not want to miss having one of the books and saving money on all types of entertainment, dinners, sporting events, services, travel, etc. Do not forget that your purchase will also help the cats of The Tenth Life. The cats earn seven dollars and fifty cents from each book sold. We usually sell three hundred books and earn nearly twenty-two hundred dollars.

Please do not forget to send your flower orders in by March 6th to allow us to secure the best prices for our customers. Also, do not forget that pre-ordering is the best way to guarantee getting the best selection of plants. We will see you on pick-up day, May 4th after 4:30pm.

By March 20th, we need your pie orders with payment for the Easter pie sale. The pies sell for nine dollars, and the flavors include apple, peach, cherry, Dutch apple, pecan, blueberry, coconut cream, chocolate cream and lemon meringue. The order blank is included in this newsletter. The pies come from Mehaffies Pie Peddler and are delicious. They are the closest pies to home made. Do not miss this opportunity. You can save yourself hours of time in the kitchen and have delicious pies for your Easter dinner. Pick-up time for the pies is April 3rd from 10:00am–5:00pm. We will have a few extra pies in case you need more pies or forget to order.

The Tenth Life apparel, tote bags, and cookbooks, catnip toys, and Kroger cards are always available at The Tenth Life, by mail, at the Yellow Springs Street Fair in June and October, and at the Beavercreek Popcorn Festival in September.

The apparel includes sweatshirts and long and short-sleeve t-shirts. The sweatshirts are twenty-five dollars and are available in gray, light blue, maroon, bright red, gold, navy, brown (light and dark), forest green, pink, and pine green. The long-sleeve t-shirts are available in bright red, pine green, medium blue, and ecru and sell for twenty dollars. The short-sleeve t-shirts come in navy, bright red, stonewashed blue and green, heathered blue and green, gray, cardinal, pebble, pine, light blue and deep forest and sell for fifteen dollars. They all have The Tenth Life logo embroidered on the front. The Tenth Life tote bags are gray with the logo embroidered in black and are twenty-five dollars. They have many pockets inside for storage. All of these are available by mail for an additional two dollars for the t-shirts or three dollars for the sweatshirts and tote bags.

The Tenth Life cookbooks are twelve dollars and have been selling very well. The cookbook has a hard cover and is loaded with three hundred and fifty delicious recipes. Why not purchase one when you visit The Tenth Life or we can send one to you for an additional three dollars for shipping. You will love the cookbook.

Even with selling all of the catnip toys that we did for the holidays, we still have a nice supply of all of the toys. We have toys shaped like strawberries (\$5.00), crocheted balls (\$2.00), crocheted pillows (\$2.00), crocheted fish (\$3.00), and mats (\$10.00). They are all handmade by volunteers and only fresh catnip is used. They are durable even for cats with claws and can be washed (refreshed) when they become well-used. Your cats will love them. They will not want any other toys once they have played with these. We can ship toys to you for one or two dollars depending on the number of toys ordered. You will make your cat(s) very happy.

The Kroger gift cards are an excellent way to support the cats without an extra outlay of your funds. They are available in twenty-five, fifty, and one hundred dollar denominations. You simply purchase the card from The Tenth Life and use it like cash until the amount is used. You then reload the card at the Kroger store and use it again. You can reload the card (cash, check, debit card or credit card) for any amount that you choose and as many times as you choose. The Tenth Life receives four percent of the value of the reloads for all the cards that we have sold. This currently equates to three to four hundred dollars per month. Kroger donates this amount, it costs you nothing. You simply buy your groceries, use the card that you purchased from The Tenth Life, and the cats are richer. It is a win, win situation. We can send a card to you, loaded with any of the amounts listed above, and you can start using it immediately. There is no additional charge for postage. Please order your card today, and begin making money for the cats by simply purchasing your groceries or Kroger gasoline. Having the card is also safer than carrying cash for your shopping.

Future Fund Raisers

On March 27th please do not forget our spaghetti dinner and auction. There will be a delicious dinner and fun-filled auctions (live and silent). You will not want to miss this night of excitement. You will be able to purchase delightful auction items at a great price and help the cats of The Tenth Life. We really hope to see you there to support the cats. If you have not attended one of our dinners and auctions, you have missed an exciting evening.

Also on April 3rd, in addition to the pie pick-up, is the Easter bake sale. We will have a huge selection of baked goods for your Easter holiday dinner. We will have cookies, cakes, and candy for all of your Easter dessert needs. The time for the bake sale is 10:00am–5:00pm. Rather than our pricing the baked goods, you decide what they are worth and make a donation. Our supporters are always very generous to the cats. See you at the bake sale.

We plan to participate in the Yellow Springs Street Fair on June 12th assuming that we have a spot. Our normal spot is on Route 68 on the left side of the street before you reach the Speedway gas station on the right. This is always a good festival for The Tenth Life and very profitable. We will have our regular merchandise plus some new items. We will see you there. Please stop by our booth, say hello, and make a purchase.

Reminders

With spring just around the corner, those of us involved in animal welfare know that kitten season will be starting. This means that millions of unwanted, homeless kittens will be born and will never have a chance to live their life. They will be put to death in many shelters around the area. Please encourage everyone you know to have their cats spayed or neutered. If you do not realize what a terrible problem this is please refer to the poster shown in this newsletter of the unbelievable number of kittens that can be produced by only two unneutered cats and a few of their offspring. It is incomprehensible if you are not

faced with this reality on a daily basis. The shelters are already so crowded with cats that too many of these kittens will be put to death or left on the streets to starve or be killed in one horrible way or another. Although this is the most important reason for spaying and neutering, there are also many other benefits of having cats spayed/neutered. Cats that are spayed/neutered have better temperaments, are more loving, and make nicer pets. Spaying and neutering also reduces the incidence of certain cancers in cats. Unspayed females are prone to breast and uterine cancer and unneutered males are subject to prostate cancer. For cats that are outside, spaying and neutering help to keep the cats from roaming so far from home. Please do everything in your power to convince people to have this surgery performed to prevent further suffering. In addition, if you have funding available, please consider helping someone who cannot afford to pay for their cat's surgery or have a stray spayed or neutered. There are many low-cost spay/neuter programs available in this area. If you call The Tenth Life, we can tell you about the local low-cost spay/neuter programs available. If we all work together, we can help to reduce this problem and hopefully eliminate it altogether in future years. The cats and kittens are counting on all of us to help them.

Please continue saving pennies, aluminum, Fresh Step Paw Points and coupons. The pennies can be wrapped or unwrapped. We appreciate them either way. The aluminum can be pet food cans, soft drink cans, spouting, siding or any other type of aluminum. A magnet will not stick to aluminum. By saving aluminum for The Tenth Life, you are helping the cats and the environment. The Fresh Step Paw Points can be found on the back of the bag at the bottom right corner, on the box or in the pail of litter. The code is usually twelve characters and is not the lot number. Sometimes they are very hard to read. If you simply cut that part of the top layer of the bag or box and send it to us, we will determine the code and use it to obtain coupons for the purchase of the litter that we use at The Tenth Life. Saving these Paw Points saves the cats thousands of dollars a year on our litter purchases. We also appreciate your saving coupons for cat food, Fresh Step litter, paper towels, facial tissue, and toilet paper.




Millions of unwanted and homeless cats are born in our country each year. During the peak of the kitten season—from late April to September—pounds and humane shelters kill unwanted and abandoned cats at the rate of over ONE PER MINUTE. Others less fortunate are left to wander—easy prey for larger animals, easy targets for automobiles and easy marks for cruel pranksters and fanatics. If they do survive these hazards and the elements, they soon attain maturity and bring forth five or six kittens, mostly females, to continue this vicious cycle. Every cat owner whose pet is unspayed or unneutered, and allowed to roam, must bear the guilt for the terrible over-population. Remember—one female cat's cumulative offspring in ten years could total over 80 million!


