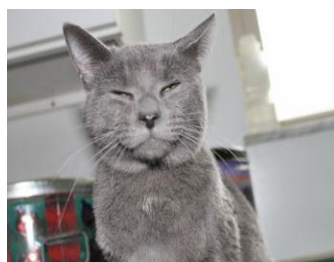

Smokey and Bandit are handsome cats that were left behind when their owner moved. They were left outside to survive and were not neutered. Bandit was terrified when he was left outside, but Smokey made the best of it. A caring neighbor took them in and brought them to The Tenth Life. They are both so loving. Smokey begs to be held, but Bandit is more reserved. Smokey is very talkative, but Bandit is quiet. As you can tell, they are about opposites of each other. Bandit is black and long hair and Smokey is gray and short hair. We assume they are litter mates. They would love to have a safe, warm home together.

Heartwarming Story

Cleo, a handsome long hair lynx-point Balinese mix came to The Tenth Life over four years ago as part of a feral litter. We had worked with him and made slow progress, but still had a long way to go before he was a true pet. We could pet him, but only for a few pets before he became afraid and would run away. A woman who had adopted from The Tenth Life many years ago had lost that cat to old age and was ready for a new friend. She looked at all of the cats, but fell in love with Cleo. After talking to him for several minutes, he finally came close enough for her to stroke the side of his face. He loved the petting, but was still very afraid to get too close. She decided after much consideration that Cleo was the cat for her even though it would take months for him to be a true pet for her. She took him home and confined him to one room. For what seemed like forever, he hid behind furniture and would only come out at night to eat and use the litter box, but she could not touch him. He now is out more of the time and has access to two more rooms. He occasionally plays in front of her and loves to watch the outside happenings. He is still very afraid for her to pet him, but is very slowly improving. He is roaming around the house at night as she finds some of his fur on her favorite spot on the couch. She has selected a very sociable girlfriend for him to help with the adjustment. He was very sociable with the other cats in his room and a playmate may bring him out of his shell faster. He is such a gorgeous cat. It is such a shame that he is so fearful. He will come around when he is ready. At least he has a home where he will be loved when he is ready to accept the attention.

New Test for Kidney Function

There is a new in-office test that can detect kidney problems at a much earlier stage. The test is known as an SDMA test. The test has been available for a few years, but it could only be done at the laboratory level. Your veterinarian had to send a blood sample to the lab to have the test run. The test is now available from IDEXX for use with the IDEXX Blood Catalyst Machine in the veterinarian office. This test is advertised that problems can be detected when 40% of kidney cells are damaged

(some have been detected at an even lower level per IDEXX). When readings on the current blood panel test detect kidney problems, the kidneys are already badly damaged. With the SDMA test, the earlier detection gives the veterinarian and the owner more time and options to work with the problem. Fluid therapy is the most common treatment for kidney problems. The fluids re-hydrate the cat and help to flush the toxins out of the body that the kidneys should have filtered and removed. Kidney or renal failure is one of the top killers of cats. This is not surprising when normal blood work does not reveal a problem until the kidneys are 75% damaged. Usually with kidney problems, the cat loses weight due to a reduced appetite because of nausea from the toxin buildup. There is also an increase in water consumption and urine output. If you see these signs, please make an appointment with your veterinarian. There can also be other causes for these symptoms that the veterinarian will examine. He/she can work with you on options.

Dayton Daily News Article

There was a very interesting article in the Dayton Daily News on January 12th about animal-rights laws. The article was written by Paul Leonard who is a local lawyer, politician, and educator who has worked for years to promote humane animal treatment and welfare. The article is about animal welfare in Ohio and legislation aimed at improving the care of all animals, especially companion animals. Ohio ranks 26th among all of the states for animal protection laws. He feels that Ohio needs to improve its ranking in this category. One improvement that he addresses is the regulation of puppy mills in Ohio. Mr. Leonard comments that Ohio voters may soon have the opportunity to vote on an amendment to the Ohio Constitution that would regulate puppy mills. He says that he generally opposes legislating by constitutional amendment, but for this issue he feels voter involvement is necessary. In his opinion, politics and money influence the legislative process, and he comments that dogs do not contribute to politicians' campaigns. He believes that politicians are not very interested in addressing animal welfare. Voters would have a more vested interest in animal welfare and in this case puppy mills. If you have the chance, you could go

on-line and read this interesting article. He is a well-known protector and promoter of animal rights. The national Humane Society is working to get signatures to get the amendment on the ballot. Puppy mills are not known for kind treatment of the dogs. We all need to help!

Lasagna Dinner and Auction Update

The date is set for the annual lasagna dinner and auction. It is scheduled for August 26th from 2:00-6:00pm. We are in the early stages of planning the event. We have several needs which include workers to visit businesses to solicit donations, workers for the event, baskets and volunteers for making gift baskets for the auction, and filler stuffing for the baskets. We will also be looking for sources for donations of soft drinks and salad bar items. We have been very fortunate to receive donations from restaurants and supporters in past years.

We are again asking our supporters for donations of items for the auction. All types of items are needed. We are not looking for yard sale items, but instead new or gently-used merchandise or vintage items. Donations of jewelry items are also needed as they seem to be good sellers. Of course, cat-oriented items are great sellers, but we have all types of merchandise for our auction. The auction is very popular and is our largest fund raiser. We can accept donations at any time during our hours of operation. If you cannot transport the items, call us and we can make arrangements for pickup. All donated items are tax deductible, and we are happy to provide a letter to you for your donation.

A Request

Our volunteers who make the catnip toys can use donated yarn and catnip. Yarn can be any color, and they can use about any kind of yard for the toys that they crochet. The sale of catnip toys is very important to our funding. Catnip toys are our biggest sellers at Street Fair and the Popcorn Festival. People visit our booth for the sole purpose of buying catnip toys for their furry feline friends. One lady, visiting the area at Christmas,

contacted us to buy toys for her cat. When she lived in the area, she bought a toy at our booth, and it is the cat's favorite toy. It was almost worn out and she needed to replace his toy. She bought all we had of that type of toy. Our volunteers use a large amount of yard and catnip for these toys. They make the toys year around and can always use more of both yarn and catnip to keep our inventory of toys well supplied. We can use any surplus you have of both of these items. The cats appreciate your help.

A Very Important Reminder

Although it is still winter, kitten season will be here much too soon. We all look forward to the warmer, nicer weather, but with it comes kittens being born that do not have homes. Too many of them will be put to death only because they were born. We must educate everyone we know about the need and importance of spaying or neutering. We have included the insert in this newsletter that shows the population explosion that occurs when only two cats and most of their offspring are not neutered and continue to reproduce for many years. The number produced is unbelievable. Unfortunately females can begin going into "heat" as early as four months (most wait until about six months), and can become pregnant as soon as three days after delivering a litter. There is no way to get ahead of this problem except to spay and neuter. We have seen cats with eight-week old kittens, ready to have another litter. There just are not enough homes for all of these kittens. Please also see the insert for the benefits of spaying and neutering. With all of the low-cost spay neuter programs in this area, there is no reason for not having cats done. Please spread the word about the over-population problem and the easy solution to it. Also tell people about the programs available to help with the expense. If you have questions about available programs, please call us, and we can offer information.

Please help us by telling your friends and relatives about the fantastic plants. We will have the same great selection as in past years. There will be annual bedding plants of many varieties, hanging baskets, flowering pots, patio pots, perennials, herbs, and vegetables. We will need your order blanks with payment by March 10th. If you cannot meet this date, we will, of course, take your order any time. **Please do not ever feel that it is too late to order.** We ask for early orders to qualify for the early-order discount offered by Furst. This allows us to keep our prices lower to help our customers. We will always amend our order to accommodate your needs and wants. If you want plants that are not listed on the order blank, simply add them. If Furst has the plants, or can get them, we will have them for you. If you prefer, you can call us, we will check with Furst on the availability, and get back to you with the information. The plants will be ready for pickup beginning at 4:00pm on May 8th until 7:00pm. The hours will be the same for each week night after that. The hours on Saturday will be 10:30am – 5:00pm and on Sunday from 12:30 – 5:00pm. Please only come during these hours so that we may assist you with your order. Many orders may look alike but may not be yours, and you could wreak havoc with our order system. We will be expecting your order.

Reminders

We appreciate your saving ink cartridges, Fresh Step Paw Points, pennies, coupons, and aluminum for the cats. We redeem the ink cartridges for rewards to purchase office supplies, and the Fresh Step Paw Points for free litter. The Paw Points can be found on the bag or box of Fresh Step Litter. The code is ten characters, but is not the lot number. Simply cut off the top layer of the bag or box with the code and mail it to our post office box. **Please be sure to cut off the entire code.** The pennies can be wrapped or not. We are thrilled to get them either way. Sending coupons for Fresh Step Litter, cat food, Yesterday's News Litter, paper towels, toilet paper, wipes (Lysol or Clorox), and facial tissue save dollars when we shop for supplies. The aluminum can be any type of aluminum from cans (pet food or soft drink) to siding and spouting. **Canned vegetable cans are steel, not aluminum, and we do not recycle them. A magnet will not stick to aluminum, but will to other metals.** Any of these can be brought to The Tenth Life during our hours of operation. Of course, the ink cartridges, Paw Points, and coupons can be sent to the post office box. Please keep saving and helping the cats.

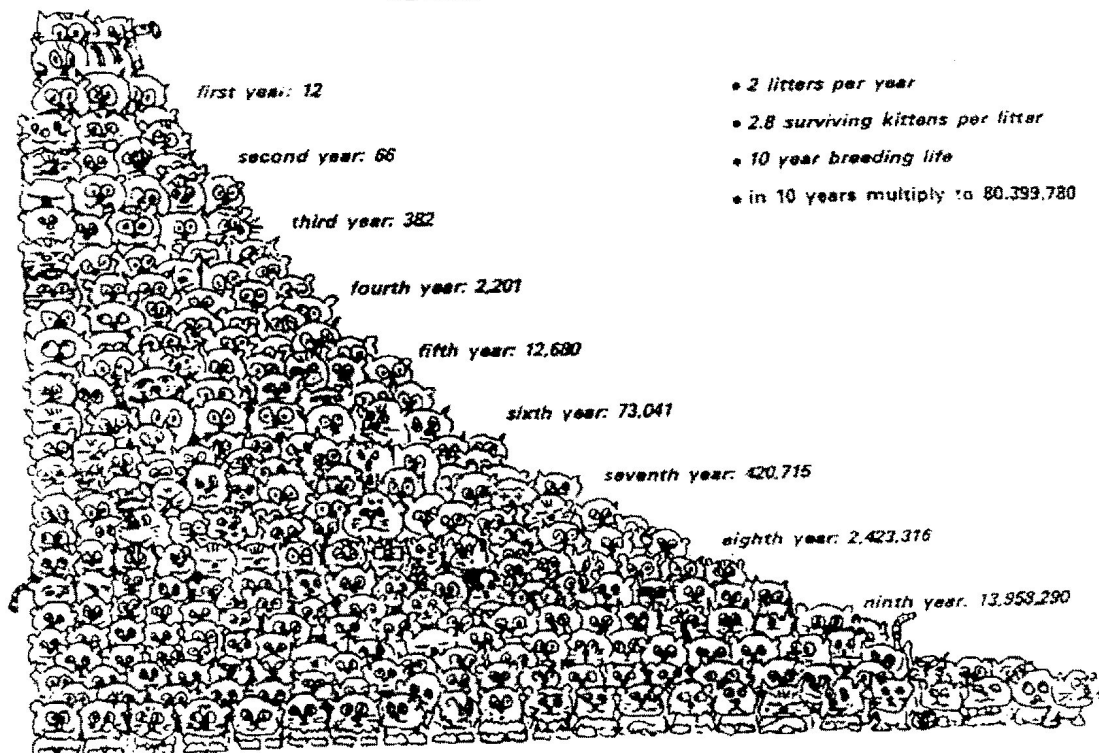
