Feature Cats

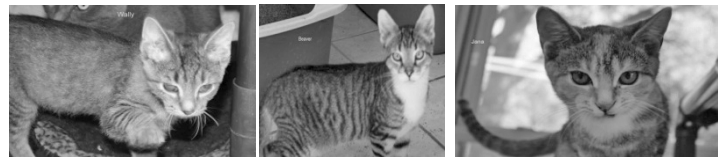
Unfortunately, Leon and Roamer have not been adopted. They are both so loving and have the most gorgeous blue/green eyes. They are fantastic, loving cats.

Our feature cats for this newsletter are Kevin, Jo-Jo and a litter whose names are Wally, Beave, and Jana. Kevin is a three-year old neutered male who is white with a little orange. He is a large cat with the sweetest disposition. He welcomes everyone to his room and immediately rolls over for overall petting. He loves to have his belly rubbed. Kevin gets along with all the other cats in his room. He has never met a stranger.

Our next feature cat for this newsletter is Jo-Jo. He had a home, but the owner died and Jo-Jo had no place to go. He was taken in by a friend of the owner, but it did not work out with her other cat who was temperamental. He is about three years old and a true love. He only has three legs, but it does not slow him down or complicate his life. He loves laps, all people and other cats. He is all black and short hair.



Lastly, Wally, Beave and Jana are litter mates who are about five months old. They arrived when they were about six weeks, and the boys both had a horrible, ulcerated eyes. Jana did not have any eye problems. We were so fearful that Wally would be blind in both eyes and Beave would lose one eye, but with lots of care,

medication, and love, they kept their eyesight. Wally's eyes are clouded a little, but he can still see and Beave has no sign of the horrible infection. We are extremely grateful. They are typical kittens who love to chase and play and get attention. Jana is more reserved than the boys since she is a female and a calico. It would be fantastic if they could all stay together.

All are spayed or neutered, blood tested for leukemia and AIDS, fully vaccinated, tested for internal and external parasites, and micro chipped. If you would like to visit them or any other cats, please call.

Heart-Warming Story

Our story for this newsletter is about eight-year old sisters who were left homeless when their "Mom" died. Their names are Bailey and Callie. They are a tiger and a calico. The transition to living in a shelter was very stressful for them, especially Callie. When they moved to a room with other cats, Callie did not eat and became jaundice. Bailey adjusted to the new environment very well. We moved them out of the room and back to the health care facility. Callie had to be hand fed and given fluids and medication for a few weeks to save her life and get her back to being healthy. After she was healthy again, a couple came looking for older cats to adopt. We showed them Bailey and Callie first and they decided that they were their new cats. They did not look at any other cats. We told them about Callie's problem, and warned them that the change to a new home could be traumatic. Fortunately, she adjusted immediately and ate very well. They are well settled into their new home and their "Mom and Dad" love them. We are very happy for these wonderful girls and very appreciative to their people for giving older cats a second chance.

Lasagna Dinner and Auction

After a great deal of thought and regret, the committee has decided to again cancel the lasagna dinner and auction. We know this saddens our supporters, but we could not justify possibly damaging people's health by having this indoor event that gets very crowded. With the number of new cases going up daily, we were fearful. We looked at many different options, such as only having the dinner as a carry-out or not having the lasagna dinner at all and only having the auction. We considered finding a different location that was larger and would allow social distancing, but the VFW Post is so convenient. We were also concerned with doing all the work required to having the event, including ordering the meals, and having a much smaller attendance which could lead to a smaller income for the cats, many left over items and leftover meals. Another group had their event and only had about a third of the normal crowd. We are all hoping that by next August, our usual timeframe for this event, that we can have our huge, fantastic dinner and auction for everyone to enjoy without all of these negative considerations. Not having the dinner and auction is a huge financial disappointment for The Tenth Life cats and volunteers as this is our largest fund raiser. However, we feel this is the best decision for the safety of everyone.

Three-Dollar Fund Tally

Thankfully, donations to the three-dollar fund have increased and now sit at thirty-one thousand dollars with some very generous donations. We thank everyone who

has contributed to this fund raiser, but if you have not already sent in your donation, please consider doing so now before the campaign comes to a close. Any extra donations to this campaign will help a little to decrease the loss of not having the auction. We welcome any additional gifts to this fund.

Cats' Christmas Wish List

The cats have been working overtime to assemble their Christmas wish list. They would really appreciate your helping in any way that you can to make their lives easier and happier. Some of these cats have come from such tragic situations, that were not their fault, that they are so appreciative of the help they receive..

With the loss of income from several cancelled fund raisers this year, our biggest need is for financial donations for everyday expenses. Both of the Yellow Springs Street Fairs and our dinner and auction being cancelled have had a tremendous reduction to our annual income for the care of the cats. In addition the price of food, litter, medications, cleaning supplies, etc. have increased significantly. We purchase everything that we can on sale, but too many of our requirements, such as medications, do not go on sale. Your donation to this fund is our top priority.

Their second request is for the donation of supplies which is always a generous way of contributing to the cats. The supplies that we use on a daily basis are paper towels, wet wipes, bleach, postage stamps and canned cat food (Friskies, Iams, or Fancy Feast),. They can be brought to The Tenth Life during our hours of operation.

There is always a need for more volunteers to care for the cats and perform other duties. The volunteers maintain the cats' rooms so that they are clean, and the cats are comfortable. Everyday the rooms are cleaned, the litter boxes are scooped, food is added and water bowls are emptied, cleaned, and refilled. It takes about nine volunteers each day to maintain the rooms. The more volunteers we have, the more time the volunteers have to interact with the cats and provide them with attention. Most volunteers work for about two hours each

week, but some spend more time depending on their availability. There is also a need for volunteers to work at our booth at festivals. We try to have shifts of volunteers rather than their having to work the entire day. For any of you who like to solicit donations from businesses, we always need more volunteers to request donations for the dinner and auction. This is a huge job, and the more volunteers we have to do this, the fewer businesses that each volunteer must visit. It makes the job easier for everyone. If any of these volunteer opportunities appeal to you and work with your schedule, please call The Tenth Life. We can use all the help we can get. You may think that you do not have time to volunteer, but please remember, we can always make time for those things that are important.

The last request is for sponsors for more of the cats. Currently about two hundred of the cats have sponsors. The rest feel badly because they do not have a special person to be their friend. For only ten dollars per month, you can sponsor one of the cats and enrich his or her life. The cats with sponsors always feel special because they know that there are extra funds to help with their needs. Of course, all of the cats receive the same care, but the ones with sponsors believe they have special benefits. When you sponsor a cat, you receive a letter from the cat about its background and its life at The Tenth Life. When the cat is adopted, you receive a letter informing you of the adoption, and an offer to sponsor another. This is a great way to help a cat and be a best friend to a cat.

A Special Offer

Several supporters of The Tenth Life have made offers to help with our fund-raising. They have offered to match donations made by others to help with the shortfall created by the missed fund raisers. You make a donation, and the cats receive your donation and the matched donation. The cats get double benefit.

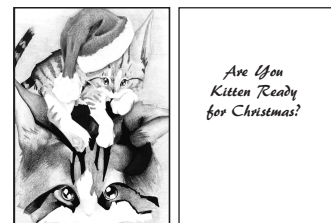
Holiday Bake Sale

The dates are December 4th, 5th, 11th, and 12th and the hours will be 1:00-4:00pm on all days. If we can do,

there will be signs at the three stores - Beavercreek, Kettering, and Centerville. Also you can call The Tenth Life to ascertain if we are doing the pictures. Sorry for being indecisive, but at this time we simply do not know. If we are able to do, the cost is ten dollars for a Santa picture in a professional picture-frame folder.

Ways to Donate to The Tenth Life

We know that many people prefer to make annual donations during the holidays. There are so many ways for you to donate to The Tenth Life and have a deduction for your taxes.

The first way anyone can donate is a direct donation by check or cash to our post office box. The donation can be any amount and is a huge help to the cats.

The second is through our web site. Donations can be made through **Just Giving** by credit card on our web site. There is a button on the home page that says donate. It will take you to the page where donations can be made. It gives you the opportunity of giving a one-time donation or a recurring donation which is charged to your credit card. The donation can be any amount. They charge us a small fee. It is fairly simple.

The Tenth Life is a Thrivent Choice organization. Thrivent Choice is a member-advised program that allows eligible members to recommend where Thrivent Financial distributes part of its charitable outreach funds each year. When eligible Thrivent Financial members direct Choice Dollars to a charitable organization, Thrivent forwards these dollars to that charity. If you are a member please consider The Tenth Life for donations or contact Thrivent to enroll.

Another way is to establish an automatic donation from your checking account if you do on-line banking. You simply register the address information for The Tenth Life located on the back of this newsletter, and the bank will send a check from your checking account. The check can be sent as often as you designate or even on a one-time basis.

Memorial donations can be made when a friend, a relative, or a pet passes away. It is a thoughtful way to memorialize the person or pet. This is being done more and more, rather than sending flowers. Unfortunately, the flowers do not last, but a donation to The Tenth Life will make a huge difference in the lives of the cats living there. The family will be notified of your memorial donation (not amount), and you will receive a letter for tax purposes.

We are hearing more and more about companies that encourage their employees to make donations to charities. In an effort to further this policy, many of the companies will match your donations to the charities. Some even double or triple your donation amount to your charity. This is a wonderful way to help The Tenth Life and make your donations even larger without any further outlay of your funds. It is a good idea to check with your employer to see if they offer a program. If they do, they usually have a form that the charity needs to complete and return to the company. You can send the form with your donation, and we will finish the process. These corporate donations really help with the funding. Many of you make holiday donations, and this is a way to make your donation even larger.

If you have reached the age where you must take a qualified distribution from an IRA, you can have this distribution check made payable to The Tenth Life. You will not be taxed on this amount as you would if the distribution were made payable to you. This is a win-win situation for you in that you do not pay taxes on the donation and the cats receive the funding.

Ideas for Holiday Gifts

You, undoubtedly, have a friend on your gift list who is a cat-lover, but for whom you have no idea for a gift. You can make a donation to The Tenth Life in that person's honor. We will send a gift notification to him or her letting the person know of your generous, thoughtful donation (not amount) in their name. You will be applauded for your generosity and creativity. As a contributor, you will also receive an acknowledgement

letter for your donation. Your donation can be a deduction to your taxes.

Sponsoring a cat for someone on your holiday gift list that loves cats is an innovative gift. The fee is only ten dollars per month. We will send a letter to your gift recipient from the cat that you choose or we choose for you based on your specifications. You will receive a letter for your taxes for the donation. Your friend will have a wonderful gift; you will have a charitable donation write off for your taxes, and the cat will have a special someone to love it. The recipient can even come and visit the special kitty.

Our apparel for The Tenth Life, tote bags, note cards, and cat toys make excellent gifts for your cat-loving friends and family and their cats. The second sale was the mum sale. We sold three hundred and twenty six mums at a profit of a thousand dollars. As always, the mums were provided by Furst Florist and Garden Center, and were large and beautiful. Our customers could not believe the size of the mums for that price.
