When his adopters visited The Tenth Life, he immediately climbed in their laps and began rubbing and purring. That sealed the deal for his adoption. He is a true sweetheart and deserves a home where he is loved. We are very happy for him.

For those of you who have visited The Tenth Life, you probably met Alex. He was a handsome orange and white cat who arrived at The Tenth Life when he was six weeks old. He had suffered a tail injury that had ripped his tail off of his body. He was found in a corn field so we never knew whether he was caught in farm equipment or someone abused him and cut off his tail. He arrived in 2008 with a massive wound where his tail had been. After a great deal of treatment, the wound healed, however, he could not pass urine or stool by himself. We had to express his urine and stool twice daily to help him. He never complained and was a very happy kitty. He played like any other kitty and loved everyone who entered his room. When visitors arrived he was the first to greet them and climb onto their laps. He was everyone's favorite cat. About a year ago, he started with kidney disease, but continued to do well with Unfortunately, on August 8, we lost our treatment. precious Alex. His room seems so empty without him even though there are other cats in the room. Alex had a special place in our hearts and will be forever missed. His picture is on the wall in this room to remind us of the fantastic cat that he was. Thank you, Alex, for being our special friend.

She usually bakes about forty varieties. We need several bakers to help supplement what she is able to do. We usually have cookies, candies, brownies, cakes and cupcakes. Any variety is great. ## Cats' Christmas Wish List

The wish list for this year has five requests. The first is for financial donations to the general fund. This is the fund that is used to cover medical expenses, utility costs, insurance, and other day to day operational costs of The Tenth Life. These funds are used strictly for the cats.

The second request is also for financial support. The emergency fund that we started to help owners who

could not afford life-saving treatments/surgeries, is lasagna provided by Belmont Catering. We thank them slowly growing, but additional funds would be very helpful. There is so much need for this help as costs have risen so greatly that many people love their pets but cannot afford any kind of emergency care. We would like to be able to provide financial help to more people with this care. Your contributions would make this possible. The fund currently has forty-five hundred dollars. Contributors of financial assistance are provided with acknowledgement letters for tax purposes.

The next request is for more volunteers to care for the cats rooms. The volunteers scoop litter boxes, clean and change water bowls, add food, change linens, mop floors, and give the cats lots of attention. Most volunteers work one day per week and the average is about two hours per day. The cats love the attention and appreciate their clean rooms. The volunteers receive lots of love from the cats and the satisfaction of knowing they are enriching the cats' lives and their own. They give you relaxation and comfort. Please consider volunteering. It takes ten volunteers per day to clean the entire facility.

The third wish is for supplies that we use on a daily They include: paper towels, wipes, bleach, basis. canned food (Friskies, Fancy Feast), Iams Indoor dry food, laundry detergent, dryer sheets, etc. Your donation of these items saves funds and our time that would be spent shopping. They can be delivered to The Tenth Life during our hours of operation. If you need pick up, we can make arrangements.

# System Update

The condition of the water at The Tenth Life has always been a problem. The water supply is from our private well. Anyone familiar with Beavercreek water knows that water in this area is very hard and very loaded with iron. Although we have always had water softeners, there has always been a problem with water bowls having a brown film from the water. Of course, this is not the best water for the cats. One volunteer for many months brought hundreds of bottles of water every week for the cats. This was a time-consuming, hard effort to do. After a while, he decided it was too much to do. The water over time had become even worse, and we had to take action. After getting several estimates and much advice, we have had a new softener installed with several filters of different types to improve the water. The water is now clear and does not have the strong odor that it once had. We are so happy to have better water for the cats. The cost was nearly four thousand dollars but it was worth it for the health and welfare of the cats. Many companies encourage their employees to donate to charities.
