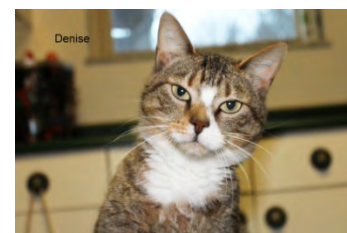
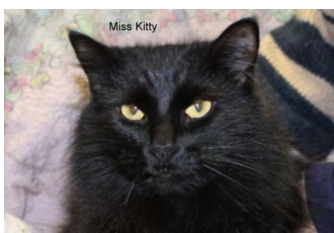

She had a tough time adjusting to her new life here. Her “Mom” was a dear friend of The Tenth Life. Miss Kitty loves to sit on laps and is fine with other cats. She is a beautiful girl who needs to be loved.

Our second feature cat is Denise. She is tiger and white and also front declawed. Of course, she is spayed. She is about two years old and very friendly. She can be with other cats or could be an only cat. Denise likes to talk to you and tell you about her day. She is a small cat with a big voice.

They can be seen by appointment. The adoption fee is seventy-five dollars, and they are ready to go to a loving home to spend the rest of their lives with love.

Heart-Warming Story

Their owners had decided to move back to North Carolina to be closer to their families. They were terrified of being out of their environment. They had a really tough time adjusting to being here and away from their people. They were very aggressive because of their fear. It took them about two weeks to adjust. A single lady who had recently moved to Ohio to be near her family, came for a cat. She fell in love with the two boys and decided they were hers. They have become her best friends and love to sit with her and be loved. They are happy again, and we are very happy for them to have a new start at a happy life.

Search for a New Veterinarian

Since the last newsletter, we thought we had the position filled, only to be disappointed. One potential doctor seemed to be the perfect fit with her experience and her love of the cats. However, at the last minute she changed her mind and turned down the position. We will never understand why she had a change of heart. The second possibility had the experience, but was in this country on a work/study visa. After working with a lawyer who specializes in visas, we decided there would be too many potential problems with hiring this veterinarian. Christmas Wish List

All of the cats' wishes were fulfilled. They have three new volunteers to help take care of them. They love the

extra attention and the additional cleaning of their areas. Of course, we can always use more volunteers. There is always so much work to do. The more volunteers we have, the better the cleaning can be done with less work for each volunteer. The work is spread among more volunteers. We thank every volunteer for their devotion to the cats and their hard work to keep the cats happy and clean. If you would like to help, please call to get started. If you have only two or three hours a week, you can be a tremendous help to the cats. The cats will reward you with purrs, rubs, and lap warming

During the holiday season, five more cats now have sponsors. They are rejoicing. It makes them feel very special to know that someone else loves them besides the volunteers. For only ten dollars per month, you can sponsor one of the cats and make it feel special also. The cat will write you letters to tell you how he or she is doing. When the cat is adopted, you will receive a letter telling you the good news and offering you the opportunity to sponsor another cat. Yes, they can use a computer.

Your donations to the general operating fund this year totaled forty-six thousand dollars. These funds will be used for the day-to-day operations of The Tenth Life. This influx of funds will last for several months and will help us meet the needs of the cats. Thank you for your donations. All acknowledgement letters have been sent. If you did not receive your letter, please notify us so that we may check on the status of your donation.

The fund for replacement of ceiling lights only advanced a small amount this year. We received about a thousand dollars for this need. We will continue accepting donations to this fund, and will add any extra funds that come in to this account. Thanks for your help.

Donations to the alarm system account were very few. We will continue to apply donations to this account until we have enough to make the purchase. We are in the process of getting more estimates for the alarm system. We feel that this is a very important purchase for the safety of the cats. We will need both break-in and fire protection. We will update you when we have the additional estimates.

Surprising Story

On December 23rd, we received a call from a lady who said that she wanted to make a donation from a trust. A couple of hours later, she arrived and took out her checkbook. She commented that she was going to write a check for forty thousand dollars, and there would be more later when everything was settled. She stated that the lady who had passed away was an animal lover, and she was dispensing her funds as she had wished. We were in total shock. Nothing like this had ever happened before. Early on the morning of Christmas Eve, we deposited the check into the account for The Tenth Life cats. We are so grateful for this wonderful windfall and intend to invest it for the cats to increase their earnings. Probably some of it will be added to the alarm account to accelerate the installation of a system.

2015 Statistical Summary

We will all try even harder this year to be more successful. The Importance of Spaying/Neutering

We have talked many times about the need for spaying and neutering. Too often this time of year, concerned, caring people will begin feeding a stray because of the colder weather. Of course, feeding is very

important, but the importance of spaying or neutering is overlooked. The person will feed the cat all winter and sometimes even let the cat into their home when the weather is super cold. They let the cat back outside when the weather warms a little. They do not think about the fact that when the weather does warm, the females will begin going into heat, and the males will be looking for a mate. Now is the time to break this cycle. At this time of year the females are not going into heat, and it is a perfect time to have them spayed to prevent the inevitable production of kittens in the spring. Of course, it is also the perfect time to have the males neutered. We realize the cost of spaying and neutering is very expensive at veterinarian offices, however, this area is rich in low-cost spay/neuter programs. Every organization has a program to help people be able to afford the procedure for their own cat or for strays. If you are not aware of these programs, you can call The Tenth Life for more information on the programs in the area. Please be aware that if a cat is going to be released back to the outside, a female that has been spayed needs to be kept indoors for a week after her surgery, and a male needs to stay in for a few days. They should not be back out climbing trees or chasing around when they have just had surgery. Just as people need a recovery time after surgery so do the cats.

Another way to help with spaying and neutering is to encourage and educate everyone you know to also have their cats spayed or neutered. If they cannot afford the surgery through their regular veterinarian, inform them of the low-cost programs in their area or tell them they can call a local shelter for information. If the cost is still prohibitive for them and can't help them, please offer your assistance so that the cat will not reproduce.

Please see the information sheet in this newsletter that shows how quickly cats reproduce and the result of this uncontrolled reproduction over several years. One cat can start an epidemic of reproduction that expands exponentially. The information sheet also depicts the advantages of having cats spayed or neutered. Of course, the main advantage is that the over-population of cats will be reduced. We desperately all need to work together to reduce this problem. Total elimination would be the ideal, but unfortunately this will not

happen. You need to remember that every cat spayed or neutered does contribute to the reduction of this problem. Please do everything you can to help cats be spayed or neutered.

Annual Plant Sale

Believe it or not, it is time to begin thinking about your plant needs for the spring of 2016. The plants will again be provided by Furst Florist and Garden Center. They have always supplied the plants for the sale and are always the best plants available. Last year we sold twenty-six thousand dollars of plants. They were so beautiful, and the cost was competitive with other nurseries. They are not “big box store” plants, but rather are the highest quality, healthiest plants you can find. Please be sure to plan to buy your plants from The Tenth Life and tell everyone you know about the sale. Although the last sale was our best, we would love to do even better this year. Please help us by telling your friends and relatives about the fantastic plants. We will have the same great selection as in past years. There will be annual bedding plants of many varieties, hanging baskets, flowering pots, patio pots, perennials, herbs, and vegetables. **We will need your order blanks with payment by March 19th.** If you cannot meet this date, we will, of course, take your order any time. **Please do not ever feel that it is too late to order.** We ask for early orders to qualify for the early-order discount offered by Furst. This allows us to keep our prices lower to help our customers. We will always amend our order to accommodate your needs and wants. If you want plants that are not listed on the order blank, simply add them. If Furst has the plants, or can get them, we will have them for you. If you prefer, you can call us, we will check with Furst on the availability, and get back to you with the information. The plants will be ready for pickup beginning at 4:00pm on May 3rd until 7:00pm. The hours will be the same for each week night after that. The hours on Saturday will be 10:30am–5:00pm and on Sunday from 12:30–5:00pm. Please only come during these hours so that we may assist you with your order. Many orders may look alike but may not be yours, and you could wreak havoc with our order system. We will be expecting your order.

Easter Pie Sale

We will again offer the delicious Mehaffies pies for Easter. The price is the same – nine dollars for the regular pies and ten dollars for the special pies. The order blank is included in this newsletter. **We need your order blank with payment by March 12th,** and the pies will be available for pick up on March 26th from 10:30am to 5:00pm. This is the day before Easter. You can have a great variety of pies, without any work, for your holiday dinner. In addition, you will be contributing funds to the cats of The Tenth Life. Please remember to send in your order blank by the due date.

Past Fund Raisers

Since the last newsletter, we have had several fund raisers. The Thanksgiving pie sale was very successful. We sold ninety-two pies at a profit for the cats of two hundred and forty-four dollars. The pies were delicious, and all pies were sold. We thank everyone who purchased pies and Mehaffies for allowing us to participate in their fund-raising program.

The weekend after Thanksgiving was our first bazaar and the wreath and Christmas plant sale. The bazaar was well received, and the sales made twelve hundred and seventy-eight dollars for the cats. We had a very nice selection of cat-related items, especially our catnip toys. The wreath and plant sale made a profit of one thousand five hundred and forty-one dollars, and all the wreaths and plants sold. We were very excited with the outcome.

On December 5th and 6th, Wickline's Garden Center in Xenia had a Christmas Open House and invited several exhibitors to participate. The Center was decorated so beautifully and made it seem more like Christmas. This is the second year that we have been invited. We took our catnip toys, cards, etc and raised one hundred and eighty-eight dollars for the cats. We met many wonderful people and informed them about the work of The Tenth Life. On December 19th, we had the second bazaar, the Christmas pie pick-up, and the Christmas bake sale. The sales for the bazaar were again very successful. She provided thirty-two varieties of cookies and candy. In total we had fifty-seven varieties of delicious home-baked goodies for our customers. We raised thirty-three hundred and thirty-five dollars on this date from the bake sale, the bazaar and donations. Future Fund Raisers

Reminders

We appreciate your saving ink cartridges, Fresh Step Paw Points, pennies, coupons, and aluminum for the cats. We redeem the ink cartridges for rewards to purchase office supplies, paper towels, Clorox wipes, etc. This saves us funding from the general funds and allows them to be used for even more important purposes.

The Paw Points can be found on the bag or box of Fresh Step Litter. The code is ten characters, but is not the lot number. Simply cut off the top layer of the bag or box with the code and mail it to our post office box. **Please be sure to cut off the entire code.**

The pennies can be wrapped or not. We are thrilled to get them either way. From the Statistical Summary you can see how the pennies add up to make dollars. Truly every penny counts.

Sending coupons for Fresh Step Litter, cat food, Yesterday's News Litter, paper towels, toilet paper, wipes (Lysol or Clorox), and facial tissue save dollars when we shop for supplies.

The aluminum can be any type of aluminum from cans (pet food or soft drink) to siding and spouting. **Canned vegetable cans are steel, not aluminum. A magnet will not stick to aluminum, but will to other metals.**

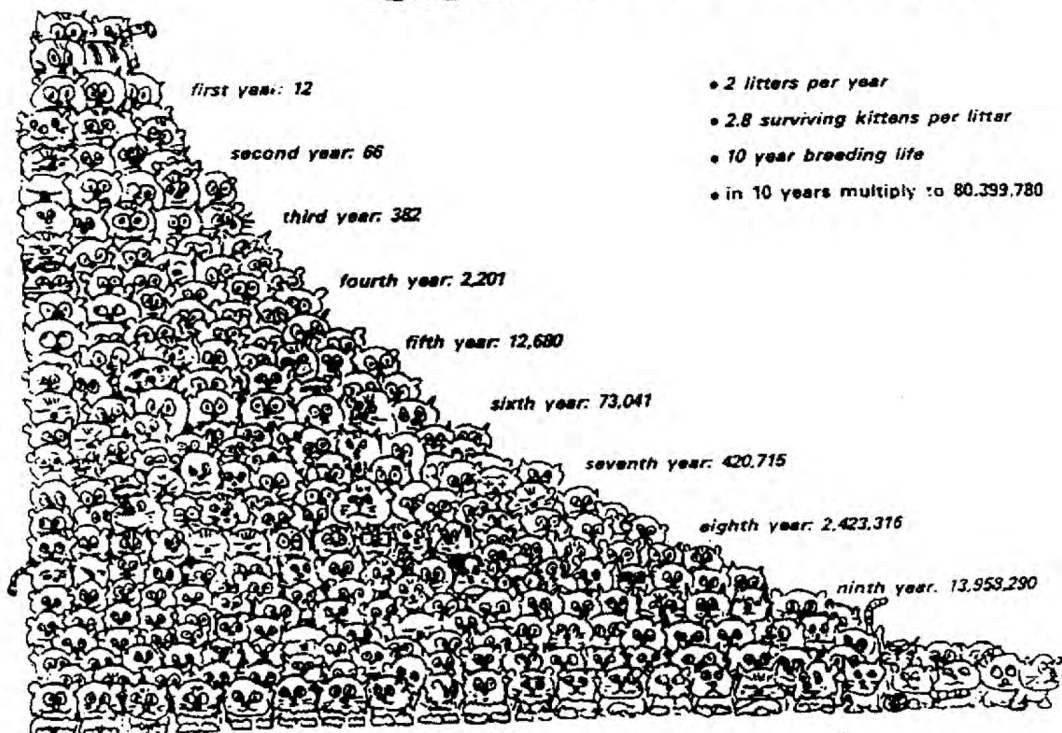

- Your pet will NOT get fat or lazy because of this surgery. Diet exercise and heredity have much more influence on the weight and attitude of your pet.
- Surgery is recommended when the pet is about four months of age, but it can be done at any age.
- It is much easier on your pet to be spayed before going through a heat cycle due to the smaller size of the reproductive tract.
- Surgery is performed painlessly while your pet is under general anesthesia. Surgical risk is minimal. Most pets go home the same day. Post-surgical pain is minimal.
