Christmas Wish List Results

As usual, we have great results to report from the requests on the Christmas wish list. A few cats have found loving homes over the holidays. Ten cats are now living in loving homes of their own rather than at The Tenth Life. They are getting very spoiled and enjoying every minute of it. We are so happy for them.

The donations to the general operating fund were very generous. We received thirty thousand two hundred dollars for the fund this holiday season. We truly appreciate your kind, thoughtful financial gifts to our operating fund. This will certainly help with the normal

expenses of The Tenth Life in 2013. Again thanks to everyone who donated.

Again, this year we received a few donations to the x-ray fund. The donations this year totaled nine hundred dollars, which brings the total to nearly sixteen thousand dollars. We appreciate your donations to this fund, and we will continue adding all donations for this purpose to the total until we have the funds needed to purchase a new x-ray unit. As long as the old x-ray continues working, we will be okay.

The donation of supplies during the holidays was outstanding. We received supplies, such as paper towels, wipes, bleach, detergent, canned and dry food, paper plates, toys, etc. Thanks to everyone who donated supplies and saved our general operating funds. Please remember that donations of supplies are accepted and appreciated throughout the year. They can be brought to The Tenth Life during our hours of operation or we can arrange for pick-up.

Since the last newsletter, the cats have found our new volunteers to take care of their needs. We welcome the new volunteers and thank them for helping with the care of the cats living at The Tenth Life. Without the volunteers, the new ones and the dedicated current ones, there could not be The Tenth Life. They make it all possible for the cats to have a place to live and be loved.

We are happy to report that six more of the cats now have sponsors. They feel so special and so loved because they have someone who belongs to them. Thank you for helping in this way. There are still many of the cats who do not have sponsors, but would love to have one. If you would like to sponsor, the cost is only ten dollars per month. The donation can be made monthly, quarterly, annually or any other way that you choose. If you would like to sponsor one of the loving cats that lives at The Tenth Life, please contact us. You can visit and pick out your own cat to sponsor or we can choose one for you based on your desires. Please consider sponsoring a cat.

The fund for the purchase of new heating/air conditioning units has a nice start. We received donations earmarked for this purpose in the amount of

eight thousand and thirty dollars. With about two more thousand dollars, we will have enough to replace two more units as the need arises. We will be able to keep the cats comfortable all year round. Thanks for all of the donations to this fund.

Helpful Hints

For your cat's safety, be sure to have identification on your cat. This can be a collar with an identification tag with your name and phone number or an embedded microchip. If your cat is microchipped, please be sure to have the microchip tag on the collar so that whoever finds him or her will know that there is a microchip. They can have the cat scanned so that they can get the cat back to you. Your veterinarian can microchip your cat for you. You may think that your cat is always indoors and does not need identification, but if a burglar breaks in and leaves a window or door open, your cat could get out. Sometimes a cat will spook and run out the door when you leave or a storm could break out a window and allow your cat to escape. We would all rather that none of these occurrences would happen, but it is better to be prepared than to be sorry after the fact.

Along this same line of having identification on your cat, it is always a good idea to have a current picture of your cat. If your cat gets lost, a current picture on the lost flyer can be very helpful. Most people are willing to watch for your lost cat, and call you if seen. A picture helps them to know that it is the lost cat that they see and not a neighbor's cat who is allowed to roam. The picture can also aid at shelters to identify your cat if it is brought to their facility. Be sure to date the picture so that you know it is current.

Another hint that we want to give is to be sure to dispose of dental floss, string, ribbon, thread in a trash can that your cat cannot find. If a cat eats any of these objects, it can become knotted in the cat's stomach or intestinal tract and cause a blockage. The dental floss can also cut holes in the intestinal tract and allow seepage of waste into the abdominal cavity causing peritonitis. Any of these results can require surgery and can even cause

the death of your cat. Please be sure to be careful with these items around your house.

Annual Plant Sale

The order blank for the annual plant sale is included in this newsletter. The plants will again be provided by Furst Florist and Garden Center. As much as possible, we have kept the prices the same. Your old favorites are still available with a few new additions. These beautiful bedding plants, hanging baskets, flowering pots, patio pots, perennials, herbs, and vegetables make beautiful, thoughtful Mother's Day gifts. They arrive on May 7th, just a few days before Mother's Day on May 12th. Your Mother, or anyone else on your Mother's Day gift list will be so pleased to have these gorgeous plants and will be thrilled that the purchase helps the cats. We must place our pre-order by March 20th; therefore **we need your orders, with payment, by March 16th** to allow us time to consolidate the orders. As always, this is early, but to get the pre-order discount which allows us to keep our prices lower, we must submit seventy-five percent of our order by this date. If you simply cannot make this date, we will certainly accept your order at any time. Even if your order is not ready until almost the time of delivery, be sure to submit it so that we can take it from the extras to be able to accommodate your floral needs. If you are interested in a plant that is not shown on the listing, please either note it on your order blank or call us, and we can check with Furst to see if they will have it or can get it for you. We can let you know of the availability and price. We always order three or four thousand dollars of extras to try to have all the plants that you need. Sometimes you might need more than you anticipated or you might see something that you like, but did not order. At the time of the sale, we can always go back to Furst and get more plants to satisfy your needs. The orders will be ready for **pick-up on May 7th after 4:30pm. Every week night after May 7th the orders will be available from 4:30-7:00pm. The hours for Saturday are 10:30am-5:00pm and for Sunday 12:30-5:00pm.** Please only come during these hours so that we are available to help you with your order so that orders are not mixed-up. If you have any questions about the

plant sale, please contact us with the phone number on the back page.

Easter Pie Sale

Our annual Easter pie sale will be held on **March 30th from 10:30am-5:00pm**. The pies will again be from Mehaffies and will be delicious as always. You can even offer your guests several flavors if you choose. The price is still nine dollars unless you order specialty pies which are ten dollars. The order blank is included in this newsletter with the pies listed. Please pre-order to be certain to get the flavors that you want. We need to have your **order, with payment, by March 16th**. We will have extras available, as always, if you forgot to order or you need more than you ordered. Unfortunately, we may not have extras of every flavor. You can save yourself time and energy by purchasing your pies for your Easter dinner from The Tenth Life.

Easter Bake Sale

On the same day as the pie sale, we will have our annual Easter bake sale. We promise to have a huge, delicious selection of candies, cookies, cakes, etc. to satisfy all of your Easter dinner dessert needs. You can offer your guests a wide variety of dessert items without spending any time preparing them. We always even have some items that are perfect for Easter baskets. Please plan to attend during the same hours as the pie sale. **If you would like to bake for this sale, you can deliver your baked goods on Friday evening March 29th from 4:30-7:00pm or after 9:30am on Saturday.**

Past Fund Raisers

Chronologically, the first fund raiser since the last newsletter was the Thanksgiving pie sale. We sold one hundred and seventeen pies at a profit of four hundred and two dollars. The pies were from Mehaffies and were delicious as always. Thanks to all of our supporters who participated. We know that you enjoyed your pies and appreciated having more time for the preparation of the

rest of your meal. We are sure that you were more relaxed and better able to enjoy the dinner.

The next event was the greenery and plant sale. The cats earned twelve hundred and eighteen dollars from the sale of the wreaths, roping and holiday plants. The greenery was so aromatic and the plants were beautiful. All the wreaths, roping and plants sold. We thank everyone who purchased their holiday greenery and plants from The Tenth Life. Please remember The Tenth Life next year.

The first bazaar was held on the same day as the wreath pick-up. The proceeds from the first bazaar were twenty-five hundred and twenty-two dollars. Everyone who made purchases was extremely generous, and we do appreciate the support of our customers.

On December 15th, we held our second bazaar and our holiday bake sale. The cats were provided with twenty-one hundred and twenty-three dollars from these two sales. The bake sale was even bigger than normal. We had about sixty-five varieties of baked goods that included cookies, candies, cakes, cupcakes, and chocolate suckers. All of our customers were so impressed with the selection and how delicious every variety was. It was a huge success. We are so appreciative of everyone who baked for this sale and everyone who made purchases. You were so generous with your donations for these baked goods and bazaar items. We intend to do both of these events again next year.

On December 15th, 22nd, and 23rd, The Tenth Life volunteers played Santa and his helper at three different pet stores so that people could bring in their pets for pictures with Santa. On December 15th we were at PetCare Solutions, the new pet store that is owned by one of our volunteers, and the Pet Bowl in Springboro. The following weekend we were again at PetCare Solutions on Saturday and at Pet Supplies Plus in Centerville on Saturday and Sunday. For the December 22nd session at PetCare Solutions, we were featured in the Daily Events Column of the Dayton newspaper. At that location, due to the publicity, we had about fifty people bring their pets for pictures. The earnings from the two weekends were

seven hundred and thirty-nine dollars. We thank the three pet stores for allowing us to have this event at their stores. Hopefully next year, we can do this fun event at the same stores. Our volunteers have so much fun playing Santa and his helper, meeting the pets and their owners, and making money for the cats. It is a win-win situation for everyone.

December 22nd was the date of our Christmas pie sale. We sold eighty-nine pies at a profit of three hundred and five dollars. Thanks to our supporters and to Mehaffies for allowing us to have these delicious pies during the year for our sales.

We sold our 2012 original-design Christmas cards at all of our events and the sales were fantastic. Everyone loved them and thought the artwork was outstanding and gorgeous. We thank the artist so much for such a beautiful card for our customers. We plan to have another card for next year.

Current Fund Raisers

For those of you who shop at Dorothy Lane Market, please register for their Good Neighbor Program where a percentage of your purchases will be donated to The Tenth Life. Even if you participated in this program last year, you must still re-register. This program has been in existence for a number of years, and The Tenth Life has participated for over fifteen years. Every February, The Tenth Life receives a check from Dorothy Lane Market for our share of this program based on the dollars spent by our supporters. After you spend a thousand dollars during the year, your purchases for the year will count toward the amount that we receive. They establish an amount that they will donate every year for this program, and then each participating organization receives its respective percentage of the total based on purchases made by its supporters. Usually, we receive four to five hundred dollars each year from this program. This is another easy, no-cost-to-you, way of helping the cats. Thanks for helping with this program.

Please remember Kroger's program for charities. To help The Tenth Life, you must register your Kroger Plus

Card with Kroger using our code. You need to go to Kroger's website, www.krogercommunityrewards.com and designate "**The Tenth Life**" and our code (**80591**) as your supported organization. If you cannot register your card yourself, please ask a friend or contact us, and we will try to register your card for you. We will need your card number to do this. For the first six months of this new method, The Tenth Life has received over three thousand dollars. Previously you had to purchase gift cards from us and reload them with funds for us to receive our distribution. With this new method, you simply show your Plus Card at the checkout, which you have to use anyway to get the sale prices, and the cats benefit as long as you have registered your card on-line as a supporter of The Tenth Life. It is so easy for everyone. We simply set back and receive a quarterly check for a percentage of all of the purchases by our supporters. You do not have to spend any of your funds except to purchase your groceries. Thanks for helping us this way.

We still have a few of the 2013 Entertainment books available. The price is thirty dollars, but they will save you hundreds of dollars when you use the coupons in the book. There are coupons for fine dining, fast food, movies, dry cleaning, sporting events, car washes, repair services, etc. The 2013 books are usable until the beginning of November. You have plenty of time to use the coupons and pay for the book many times. By using just the LaComedia coupon, you recoup the cost of the book over two times. We have the books at The Tenth Life or at Dayton South Veterinary Clinic in Kettering on Wilmington Pike.

Please continue saving and transferring your Speedway Rewards to The Tenth Life. Per Speedway, you can transfer your points to The Tenth Life at the kiosk at any Speedway Station or online at Speedway's website. If you have problems at the station, ask the manager for help or call their headquarters. If you transfer your points to the following card number – 404440 098106, we can obtain one hundred dollar vanilla visa cards for purchasing supplies for the cats. If you transfer your points to The Tenth Life, the cats will greatly benefit from your generosity, and it will not cost you any of your own funds. Thanks for helping in this way.

We continue to have our t-shirts (short and long sleeve), sweatshirts, tote bags, Pet Hair Magnets, Furminators, and catnip toys. The short sleeve t-shirts (\$15.00) are available in pale yellow, pale pink, jade, pistachio, spruce, sand, light sand, natural, purple, navy, bright red, cardinal, orange, forest green, stonewashed blue and green, light blue, Carolina blue, burgundy, deep teal, light steel, pebble, khaki, olive, and medium blue. We have the long sleeve t-shirts (\$20.00) in bright red, natural and stonewashed blue and green. The Pet Hair Magnets (\$15.00) are terrific at removing pet hair from your clothes, furniture, carpeting, or anything else in your house that collects pet hair. They are so useful and handy to have.

The Furminators (\$25.00) are used to remove loose hair and mats from your cat or dog. They do not tug and pull like a comb and scare the cat or dog. They work wonders on your pet's coat. When you get the loose hair out of your pet's coat, the coat will be much softer and shinier.

Our handmade catnip toys are the best. All of our toys are made by our volunteers who only use fresh catnip, which has a much stronger scent than imported catnip, and washable fabric or yarn. The selection includes (small and large) catnip balls (\$2.00), crocheted or fabric catnip fish (\$3.00), catnip mats in attractive, cat fabric (\$10.00), furry beds filled with catnip (\$10.00), cylindrical crocheted toys filled with bells (\$3.00), and bags of dried catnip (\$3.00). We promise that your cats will love them.

Also by March 16th, you need to send in your pie order, with payment, for your Easter pies. The pies will be available on March 30th from 10:30am-5:00pm. Ordering from The Tenth Life will save you several hours in the kitchen and will help the cats.

Do not forget that on the same day as the pie pick-up, we will have our Easter bake sale during the same hours. For those of you who have previously visited our bake sales, you know that the selection is unbelievable, and the baked goods are so delicious. If you have not participated in our bake sales, you have missed the best baked goods on this earth. Be sure to mark it on your calendar.

On April 15th, we will begin the three dollar donation drive. This is our easiest fund raiser, but it raises about fourteen thousand dollars each year for the cats. We ask that everyone who receives The Tenth Life newsletter, donate a mere three dollars. This is such a small amount that we would like everyone to participate. We could ask for more, and many do send more, but we like to keep the request at a level that is not a burden to anyone. We know you like to help the cats, and it makes you feel good to be able to help. To be able to raise this large of an amount, with such a small request is outstanding. Your continued help with this fund raiser is wonderful and very appreciated. In our next newsletter, we will request that you send your three dollars. If you prefer to send your donation now, please mark it for the three dollar fund. We will send acknowledgement letters for all donations over twenty dollars. We receive so many

donations for this fund raiser, it is almost impossible to acknowledge every donation; therefore we use over twenty dollars as the cut off. If your donation is less than twenty dollars, and you want a letter, please note this with your donation, and we will gladly send a letter to you. Thanks for your help with this fund raiser.

For your future planning, we have requested 2013 books from Entertainment that we can give to our customers who purchase a 2014 Entertainment book. We do not know for sure if we can obtain any books. Reminders

Although it is still winter, kitten season will be here before long. Please educate everyone you know about the importance and need for spaying or neutering their cats. Many people do not realize how important it is to have this surgery done. This is the only way to reduce the over-population problem and possibly someday eliminate it. Millions of cats die each year in shelters because of the number of unwanted cats. Unfortunately, they were born only to die. In addition, spayed or neutered cats are much calmer and nicer pets for the family. Many cats, both males and females, that are not spayed or neutered develop behavioral problems, such as aggressiveness and litter box usage problems. If a cat is spayed or neutered at an early age, such as four or five months, these problems usually do not develop. Another

factor to stress to cat owners who do not have their cats spayed or neutered, is that cats who have this surgery are much less prone to many types of cancer. Unspayed females are likely to develop breast and uterine cancer, and unneutered males are very likely to suffer from prostate and testicular cancer. Trying to treat these problems leads to costly vet bills and too often the death of the cat. There are so many low-cost spay/neuter programs in this area, that people can utilize to reduce the cost of the surgery. Many areas, especially rural areas, do not have such programs. When you talk to people about the need for spaying and neutering, emphasize that these programs do exist and can help them to be able to afford the surgery. Anyone can call The Tenth Life, and we will be happy to provide information about low-cost spaying and neutering available in this area. Please do your part to encourage people to be responsible and have their cats spayed or neutered.

If you have not indicated to us your choice of method of receiving the newsletter, (mail or e-mail) please contact us. The address and phone number are listed at the end of this newsletter. The e-mail address is jlotsacats@aol.com. If receiving e-mail notification is convenient for you, please notify us, and we will convert you. If you prefer receiving the mailed copy tell us this, and we will continue sending a hard copy to you. Simply let us know your preference. If you have already answered this request, you do not need to respond again. Thank you for helping us reduce the printing and postage cost of our newsletters by changing to e-mail.

We appreciate your saving ink cartridges, Fresh Step Paw Points, pennies, coupons, and aluminum for the cats. We redeem the ink cartridges for rewards to purchase office supplies, and the Fresh Step Paw Points for free litter. The Paw Points can be found on the bag or box of Fresh Step Litter. The code is twelve characters, but is not the lot number. Simply cut off the top layer of the bag or box with the code and mail it to our post office box. Please be sure to cut off the entire code. The pennies can be wrapped or not. We are thrilled to get them either way. Sending coupons for Fresh Step Litter, cat food, Yesterday's News Litter, paper towels, toilet

paper, wipes (Lysol or Clorox), and facial tissues save dollars when we shop for supplies. The aluminum can be any type of aluminum from cans (pet food or soft drink) to siding and spouting. **Canned vegetable cans are steel, not aluminum. A magnet will not stick to aluminum, but will to other metals.** Any of these can be brought to The Tenth Life during our hours of operation. Of course, the ink cartridges, Paw Points, and coupons can be sent to the post office box. Please keep saving and helping the cats. We appreciate your help with these collections. They all make a huge difference in our funding and cost you nearly nothing. The cats say a huge thank you.

Many of our supporters have been saving pill bottles for The Tenth Life for years, and it has been truly appreciated. However, we now have a sufficient supply

for quite awhile. When we again have a need, we will notify everyone through the newsletter and on the website. Thanks so much for your unbelievable response to this request.
