He adopted Ricky and was very willing to work with him. With every follow-up call, he reported progress with Ricky. Ricky has now become a friendly, loving companion who even likes laps. Ricky is very lucky to ever have a chance to have a home and be loved. He had the opportunity to become a loving pet and has succeeded very well.

Exciting News about Our Veterinarian Position

In October we began a new advertising medium specifically for Shelter Veterinarians. Within two weeks we had a response from a very qualified young lady in a city south of Beavercreek. Her resume was loaded with the type of experience we have been seeking for two years. Later that week, we interviewed her and came to an agreement on working hours, responsibilities, salary, etc. We hired her immediately. She had previous commitments which did not allow her to start her full duties until the first of 2017. However, she had a few days in her work schedule which allowed her to work for us two days in November and two in December. She has done enough spays, neuters, and declaws that we are almost caught up. Dr. Amanda Ortiz is a graduate of Ohio State (undergrad and vet school), and has worked in animal clinics and a no-kill shelter. Therefore, she has an understanding of how we differ from other organizations, and from veterinary clinics. We are very comfortable with her work ethic and vast knowledge of treatment protocols.

After searching for two years, it is truly a relief to have a very qualified, cooperative doctor as part of our organization. We have promised her that we will keep her very busy and will challenge her on a daily basis. Given the number and variety of cats that we have and the conditions that we see, we will provide her with a magnificent learning experience. This is a win/win situation. Welcome Dr. Amanda!!

Warning Signs of Illness in Your Cat

We know that you love your cat(s) and want to take great care of them. We wanted to offer some signs that can indicate that a cat is not feeling well. Many people have made the comment that they did not realize that their cat was ill or they did not recognize the signs the cat was displaying. On the next page there is a list of changes you might see in your cat that could require veterinary attention. If you have questions, you can call your veterinarian for information or The Tenth Life for advice.

Christmas Wish List Results

INDICATORS OF HEALTH PROBLEMS IN CATS

- Changes in behavior – even minor changes, such as not meeting you at door
- Temperature above 102.5 degrees or below 100 degrees
- Lethargy
- Loss of appetite
- Increased appetite
- Excessive water consumption
- Failure to drink water
- Dehydration/pull up skin on back of neck/if doesn't snap down like elasticized/ cat is dehydrated
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Blood in stool
- Indiscriminate urination
- Blood in urine
- Straining in litter box
- Frequent trips to litter box
- Crying or running when trying to urinate
- Smaller than normal urine spots in litter box
- Constipation
- Coughing
- Sneezing
- Nasal discharge
- Eye discharge
- Redness in the inner eye lids
- Cloudiness in the eye
- Trouble chewing food/ twisting head to side when chewing
- Salivation dripping from the mouth
- Gum color very pale pink/white/yellow
- Tartar buildup on teeth
- Red spots or lumps in mouth
- Dirt in ears
- Cat digging ears/shaking head excessively
- Limping
- Stumbling/staggering
- Tenderness on the body
- Lumps on the body
- Swollen spots on body
- Blood on the body

Renewal of Registration of Kroger Plus Card

Please remember that in April you must renew the registration of your Kroger Plus Card with Kroger to continue supporting The Tenth Life with your purchases

at Kroger. The renewal should be done on-line as you have done each year. If we have done your renewal for you in the past, we will again do it this year. You will not have to do anything. If you have questions, you can call The Tenth Life for assistance or the number at Kroger on the back of your Plus Card.

Renew Your Registration at Dorothy Lane Market

Dorothy Lane Market requires your renewal of your Good Neighbor Program registration to support the Tenth Life. Please do this at Dorothy Lane Market in January so that your purchases will count toward the total of dollars that the cats receive through this program. Last year we received over seven hundred dollars contributed as a percentage of all purchases supporting The Tenth Life.

Update Address and Phone Changes to Micro Chip Companies

If you move or change your phone number, it is so important to provide these changes to the micro chip company where your pet is registered. If the cat was adopted from The Tenth Life, the company is Home Again and the number is on the micro chip tag. If your pet is micro chipped by a different company please find the companies phone number or website to make the necessary changes. This is so important if your pet gets lost. You do not want the company to try to reach you and not be able to do so. Your beloved pet could be sent to a shelter and be destroyed or adopted to someone else. Please be sure to make these changes. If the cat was adopted from The Tenth Life, please be sure to make us aware of the changes also. Thank you.

Special Offer for Cat Carriers

We always encourage everyone to use cat carriers whenever transporting your cat. We have an abundance of carriers of several different sizes. They range in price from ten dollars to twenty dollars depending on size. We have both hard plastic and fabric carriers (limited

number). You will need to come to The Tenth Life to see the selection. They are all in excellent condition.

Annual Plant Sale

With the cold weather, it is hard to believe it is time to begin thinking about your plant needs for the spring of 2017. Please remember, thinking about the plants will make it seem like spring is near. The plants will again be provided by Furst Florist and Garden Center. They have always supplied the plants for the sale and are always the best plants available. Last year we sold twenty-eight thousand dollars of plants. They were so beautiful, and the cost was competitive with other nurseries. They are not big box store plants, but rather are the highest quality, healthiest plants you can find. Please be sure to plan to buy your plants from The Tenth Life and tell everyone you know about the sale. Although the last sale was our best, we would love to do even better this year. Please help us by telling your friends and relatives about the fantastic plants. We will have the same great selection as in past years. There will be annual bedding plants of many varieties, hanging baskets, flowering pots, patio pots, perennials, herbs, and vegetables. We would like to have your order blanks with payment by March 11th. If you cannot meet this date, we will, of course, take your order any time. **Please do not ever feel that it is too late to order.** We ask for early orders to qualify for the early-order discount offered by Furst. This allows us to keep our prices lower to help our customers. We will always amend our order to accommodate your needs and wants. If you want plants that are not listed on the order blank, simply add them. If Furst has the plants, or can get them, we will have them for you. If you prefer, you can call us, we will check with Furst on the availability, and get back to you with the information. The plants will be ready for pickup beginning at 4:00pm on May 9th until 7:00pm. The hours will be the same for each week night after that. The hours on Saturday will be 10:30am – 5:00pm and on Sunday from 12:30 – 5:00pm. Please only come during these hours so that we may assist you with your order. Many orders may look alike but may not be yours, and you could wreak havoc with our order system. We will be expecting your order.

Easter Pie Sale

We will again offer the delicious Mehaffies pies for Easter. The price is the same – nine dollars for the regular pies and ten dollars for the special pies. The order blank is included in this newsletter. We need your order blank with payment by April 1st, and the pies will be available for pick up on April 15th from 10:30am to 5:00pm. This is the day before Easter. You can have a great variety of pies, without any work, for your holiday dinner. In addition, you will be contributing funds to the cats of The Tenth Life. Please remember to send in your order blank by the due date.

Easter Bake Sale

Past Fund Raisers

Since the last newsletter, we have had many events to raise funding for the cats. The first was the Yellow Springs Street Fair in October. The volunteers sold merchandise totaling almost one thousand dollars. We had the Thanksgiving pie sale, the holiday wreaths, greenery and plant sale, the first holiday bazaar, the Wickline holiday event in Xenia, the pictures with Santa at three Pets Supplies Plus, the second bazaar, the Christmas pie sale, and the Christmas bake sale. All the sales were huge successes and earned significant dollars for the cats' needs. The Thanksgiving pie sale raised two hundred and sixty-one dollars for the cats. The next event, the wreaths, greenery and plants produced over fifteen hundred dollars for the cats. All the wreaths, roping, and plants sold. They were beautiful and so aromatic. The two holiday bazaars accounted for nearly three thousand dollars for the cats. The Wickline event produced less funding than last year, but the volunteers enjoyed the event. Pictures with Santa were fun for the volunteers who were Santa and his helper. They took pictures of mostly dogs but a few other pets were brought in for a Santa visit. They raised nearly thirteen hundred dollars for the two weekends. The Christmas pie sale was great. We sold over eighty pies and made two hundred and sixty-two dollars. The Christmas bake sale was, as always, very popular. Thanks to our wonderful

bakers, we had sixty-two varieties of delicious baked goods. There were cookies, cakes, cupcakes, breads and candy. The profit from the bake sale was over thirteen hundred dollars.

We wish to thank those who made these sales possible. Furst Florist and Garden Center provided the gorgeous Christmas plants. Mehaffies Pie Peddler made the holiday pies. Wickline Florist Garden Center allowed us to participate in their event. Pets Supplies Plus in Beavercreek, Kettering, and Centerville allowed us to do Pictures with Santa. The generous bakers who spent hours preparing the delicious baked goods for our sale are invaluable. Of course we also have to thank all of our supporters who made purchases from these events. Finally, we thank the volunteers who worked these events and gave their time to help the cats. It takes all of these people to make the events successful and profitable. Thank you.

We have concluded the 2016 three dollar campaign. The final total was seventeen thousand, six hundred and fifty-five dollars. It was only slightly short of the goal of eighteen thousand dollars. Your support of this easy fund raiser for The Tenth life was outstanding and greatly appreciated. The 2017 campaign will begin on April 1st.

The sale of Entertainment books has also concluded. We only sold forty-four books at a profit of less than four hundred dollars. This was a disappointing year for this sale. We will evaluate whether the sale of these books is worthwhile when considering the sale next year. We will inform you about this matter.

The cat furniture built by a volunteer is available for your shopping pleasure. We have a book at The Tenth Life showing the different designs available. The trees that he makes have a large base for stability and are constructed of PVC or sturdy wood covered with carpet, and the posts can be covered with carpet or sisal. Prices vary by height and style. You can choose the color of carpet that you prefer. You and the cats will be thrilled with the furniture.

We have a wonderful selection of short (\$15.00) and long-sleeve (\$20.00) t-shirts, polo shirts (\$25.00) sweatshirts (\$25.00), and tote bags (\$25.00). The short sleeve t-shirts are available in pale yellow, pale pink, jade, pistachio, spruce, sand, light sand, natural, purple, navy, bright red, orange, forest green, stonewashed blue, light blue, Carolina blue, burgundy, deep teal, light steel, pebble, khaki, olive, and medium blue.
