They are about five months old and are tiny for their age. They were both sick, but Polly recovered very quickly. However, Jim was ill for quite awhile. We were afraid that he was not going to make it. He has now gained weight and is a true love. Both are very affectionate and are typical kittens, but Jim is more aggressive with his love. If you bend over, he is on your back and wrapping himself around your shoulders giving face bumps. All of the volunteers adore him and her also, of course. They are an amazing pair of kittens that would enrich your life.

Nugget is our next adoptable cat. He is about two and a half years old. He was found in the middle of North Fairfield Road at the age of eight weeks. He had been hit by a car and luckily only lost the tip of one ear. When he was about seven months old, he was adopted with an adult cat who became intimidated by Nugget after about a year and a half. Therefore, Nugget was returned. He is now in a room with cats of all ages and has never shown any aggression, playing or otherwise. He greets all visitors to his room and expects attention from everyone. Nugget is a front-declawed, longhair black and white large boy who would love to have a home where he can stay for the rest of his life.

Heartwarming Story

Our story for this newsletter is about Teeny. Teeny belonged to an elderly lady who adored him but she passed away. Her daughter took him to be a friend to her female cat. However, the resident cat was very afraid of Teeny even though he did not bother her in any way. After three months of trying and having her kitty hide most of the time, she asked if Teeny could come here. He was afraid, at first, but adjusted very quickly to being here. He talked to all the volunteers and begged to be held. Of course, he had to be in a cage at first while we did blood testing and fecal samples. Teeny would stick his front leg through the bars of the cage asking to be held. As soon as we would pick him up, he would immediately wrap his front legs around your neck and begin sucking on your clothing. At the same time he would be purring constantly. When we would return him to his cage, he would get up on his rear legs, put his front paws together and move them forward like he was begging. In all the years and all the cats we have seen we never saw a cat do that. When a lady came in with a volunteer, she asked about seeing the cats. We immediately showed her Teeny. When she opened the cage door, he was immediately in her arms, with his legs wrapped around her neck and sucking on her shirt. She immediately knew that Teeny was her cat. He went home a few days ago and was not enamored with her small dog. They are still adjusting to each other. He is very loved and very happy to have another home. We are excited for him and some have a video of his begging.

A Very Important Reminder

Although it is still winter, kitten season will be here much too soon. We all look forward to the warmer, nicer weather, but with it comes kittens being born that do not have homes. Too many of them will be put to death only because they were born. We must educate everyone we know about the need and importance of spaying or neutering. Unfortunately females can begin going into "heat" as early as four months (most wait until about six months), and can become pregnant as soon as three days after delivering a litter. There is no way to get ahead of this problem except to spay and neuter. We have seen

cats with eight-week old kittens, ready to have another litter. There just are not enough homes for all of these kittens. With all of the low-cost spay neuter programs in this area, there is no reason for not having cats done. Please spread the word about the over-population problem and the easy solution to it. Also tell people about the programs available to help with the expense. If you have questions about available programs, please call us, and we can offer information.

Please alert people to the advantages of spaying and neutering. Of course, the main advantage to spaying and neutering is that the cats will not reproduce and add to the already horrific over-population problem. In addition, the likelihood that a cat will spray is greatly reduced. Spaying female cats eliminates the chance for uterine and ovarian cancers and greatly reduces the chance of breast cancer. Neutering male cats prevents testicular cancer and greatly reduces the occurrence of prostate cancer. Finally, spayed or neutered cats are much more relaxed and less aggressive. Therefore, are better pets. Please pass this information on to everyone you know who needs more information about the need for spaying and neutering.

Three Dollar Fund Tally

This was another successful campaign for the cats thanks to your generosity. The final total for 2019 was thirty-one thousand dollars. With the increased cost of everything that we purchase for the cats, this income will help tremendously. We already have higher prices from all of our medical, food and litter suppliers. This eats up the income very quickly. Thank you so much to everyone who contributed to this campaign. The 2020 three dollar campaign will begin April 1st. Please help again.

Danger of Feeding Grain-Free Food

Recently, we had a cat with heart problems at a cardiologist. The first question the doctor asked was if we feed grain-free food. She responded that she is seeing cats and dogs with heart problems that are caused by feeding grain-free food. This food does not contain

All pets should be surgically spayed/neutered for many reasons. In addition to improved health and behavior resulting from this surgery, you will be doing your part to reduce unwanted pet population. Millions of unwanted animals are euthanized each year because good homes are limited.

- Prevents signs of heat
- Prevents blood stains on carpet from heat cycle
- Decreases chance of breast tumors
- Eliminates chance of cystic ovaries
- Eliminates chance of uterine infections

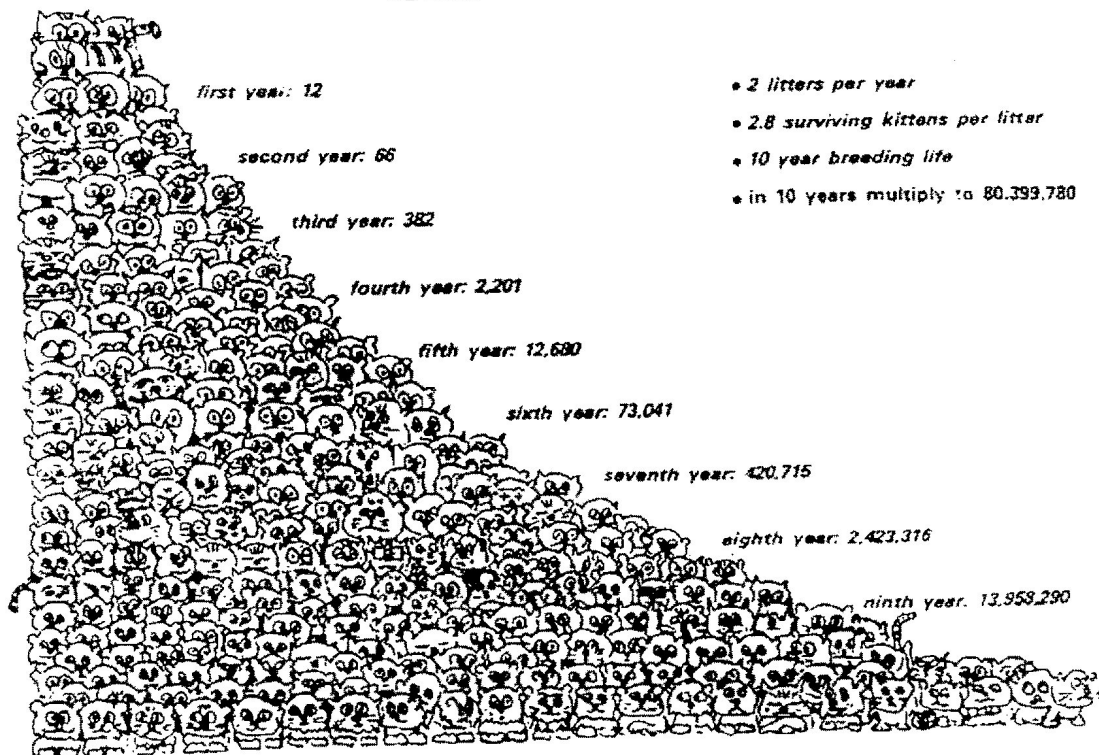

Do not let this happen to you and your pet. Please call your pet's micro chip company today and make any necessary changes.

Results of the Christmas Wish List Requests

The first item on the list was for donations for repairing and recoating the blacktop driveway. Although no donations came in earmarked for this need, we have been contacted by a company that does this kind of work. Unfortunately, the timing of our newsletter was a

little late in the year for this type of work to be done. Hopefully in the spring, we can work with this company and get the necessary repairs and recoating done.

The second request was for donations to kickoff a fund for two new pieces of equipment. We received donations for this fund totaling two thousand dollars. We appreciate your support of these needs, and we will continue saving for these needs until funding is sufficient for the purchases.

Donations to the general operating fund this holiday season totaled twenty-eight thousand seven hundred dollars. These funds will be used for day-to-day expenses such as the doctor's salary, medical needs, food, litter, insurance, etc. These are the most important funds that we have to continue serving the needy cats that arrive and live here.

Supply donations were not as numerous as in past years. Although we received donations of paper towels, wipes, food, etc., there were still less of them than normal. We do appreciate those that we received. Supply donations can be made throughout the year and really help with expenses for them. Please continue supporting this need.

The cats also asked for more volunteers, but unfortunately no new volunteers have arrived. We always have this need and would appreciate your help. If you could give at least two hours once per week, it would make a huge difference to the cats and the other volunteers. You would be so rewarded by the cats with purrs, licks and warm laps. You would help to clean the rooms occupied by the cats. Please consider volunteering and helping the cats. You always can find time to do those things that you want to do and are important to you. Please consider helping. Even if you can only help every other week, that would still be great. We need volunteers not only to help clean the cats' rooms, but also volunteers to solicit donations for the auction, and to work at our dinner and auction and our booth at festivals.

The final request was for more sponsors for the cats. We only received two new sponsors and each sponsors

one cat. These two cats are so excited to have a sponsor. There are still many other cats that do not have a sponsor but would love to have one. If you have thought about sponsoring, but have not done so, please do it now. It is only ten dollars per month to help a cat that needs a special someone. Please help in this way.

We thank everyone who contributed to these requests. Your help is what makes it possible to help cats that have no where else to go to seek shelter, food and love.

Dorothy Lane Market Good Neighbor Program

They are not big box store plants, but rather are the highest quality, healthiest plants you can find. Please be sure to plan to buy your plants from The Tenth Life and tell everyone you know about the sale. Although the last sale was fantastic, we would love to do even better this year. Please help us by telling your friends and relatives about the fantastic plants. We will have the same great selection as in past years. There will be annual bedding plants of many varieties, hanging baskets, flowering pots, patio pots, perennials, herbs, and vegetables. We will need your order blanks with payment by **March 14th**. If you cannot meet this date, we will, of course, take your order any time. **Please do not ever feel that it is too late to order.** We ask for early orders to qualify for the early-order discount offered by Furst. This allows us to keep our prices lower to help our customers. We will always amend our order to accommodate your needs and wants. If you want plants that are not listed on the order blank, simply add them. If Furst has the plants, or can get them, we will have them for you. If you prefer, you can call us, we will check with Furst on the availability, and get back to you with the information. The plants will be ready for

pickup beginning at 4:00pm on May 5th until 7:00pm. The hours will be the same for each week night after that. The hours on Saturday will be 10:30am – 5:00pm and on Sunday from 12:30 – 5:00pm. Please only come during these hours so that we may assist you with your order. Many orders may look alike but may not be yours, and you could wreak havoc with our order system. We are again asking our supporters for donations of items for the auction. All types of items are needed. Past Fund Raisers

There were so many fund raisers since the last newsletter. November and December were very busy months for The Tenth Life. The Thanksgiving pie sale was a huge success. We sold one hundred pies at a profit of four hundred and twenty-seven dollars. The pies were delicious and a huge favorite among our customers.

The greenery sale was the largest ever. We sold over one hundred and thirty wreaths, rolls of roping and plants at a profit of twelve hundred and seventy-nine dollars. The plants were again provided by Furst the Florist and were gorgeous. The wreaths had such a fantastic aroma and were so beautiful and festive. We thank Unique Designs for the beautiful bows on each wreath. Unfortunately, they are closing after many years of operation and supporting The Tenth Life. We are very grateful for their help throughout the years with the wreath sale. We are so sorry to see them close. Best of luck in your new endeavors

The first bazaar on November 30th was very helpful to the cats. We sold seven hundred and fourteen dollars of our merchandise, such as catnip toys, greeting cards, and apparel of The Tenth Life, etc.

In December we did pictures with Santa at Pets Supplies Plus in Beavercreek, Kettering and Centerville for two weekends. The Santas and their helpers earned nearly nine hundred dollars for the kitties. Of course, most of the critters were dogs with a few cats also. However, the most unusual were two Scottish Highland cows brought into the Centerville store. The picture of Santa with the two cows was recently featured in the

Dayton Daily News on the Focus Page. Pictures with Santa is a favorite with our Santas and their helpers. It is so nice seeing all of the loved pets being brought in for pictures. We truly thank the volunteers who were Santa and his helper. In all, eleven volunteers worked this event. We also thank the customers who brought pets for pictures and Pets Supplies Plus for allowing The Tenth Life this opportunity.

The Christmas pie sale was also profitable for the cats (\$313). As always, the pies come from Mehaffies Pie Peddler and are delicious. We have had some new customers for our pie sales, and they are so impressed with the flavor of the pies. Our next pie sale is April 11th for Easter.

The Christmas bake sale was the most profitable ever. We made nearly eleven hundred dollars from the bake sale. There were forty-eight varieties of cookies and candies. We were a little worried about this sale because our main baker is having some health problems and was not sure how much she could bake for us. She made forty-three varieties and the other bakers made the rest. We are very grateful to all of the bakers who contributed and to our loyal customers who were so generous with their purchases. Our next bake sale is April for Easter.

The final bazaar for 2019 was very busy and made a nice profit for the cats. We sold six hundred and twenty-five dollars of merchandise.

We thank all of our contributors and all of our customers who made these fund raisers profitable for the cats to assist in the funding of their care.

We also completed our Entertainment book sale in December. We sold twenty-four books at a profit of nearly two hundred dollars.
